

VISITOR STUDY PROGRAM

Innovations and Advances in Theory, Practice, Education, and Research

INDIVIDUALIZED COLLABORATIVE STUDY

The Institute offers a Visitor Study Program for clinicians and teachers who want to study at the Institute for defined time periods. Teaching and learning at the Institute are based on a collaborative model in which participation and curiosity is encouraged. Programs are tailored to each visitor's interests and needs. Upon arrival, the Institute assigns each visitor a faculty member as the visitor's learning consultant. Visitors are invited to observe and participate in on-going clinical and training programs, including: therapy sessions, teamwork, seminars and case consultation.

Ample time and opportunity are provided for interaction with faculty and other learners on a formal and informal basis. Visitors may also pursue specialized projects during their experience at the Institute. All visitors have access to the Institute's library of texts and videotapes for independent study. Visitors seeking clinical case or program consultation during their visit should request, in advance, an appointment for the consultation.

International visitors have the opportunity to learn about the history of family and systems theory in the United States, and about the current psychotherapy theory and practice in both private and public sectors. *English is the official language of the Institute.*

SCHEDULE

Visitors may attend the Institute on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis. Visits should be arranged in advance, so that schedules can be made to provide the best possible learning experience. Visitors are requested to submit a choice of dates; although we attempt to schedule the visit during the preferred time period, it is not always possible. Scheduling is subject to the teaching and clinical commitments of the faculty and the Institute's training agenda.

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS

Each study day provides a minimum of *six (6)* Continuing Education Hours. A Certificate of Attendance is provided for use in documentation of your personal or work setting records.

PAYMENT

Full payment is requested prior to visiting the Institute. International visitors are requested to pay in U.S. dollars and may pay upon arrival at the Institute. We accept *American Express, VISA & MC* charge cards. **Fees:** \$160 per day; \$750 per week; \$3000 per month; \$110.00 per hour (for individual consultation). **Discounts are provided for ICCP students and faculty. Please ask for more information.**
